*The study was conducted for the Pew Hispanic Center via telephone by ICR, an independent research company. Interviews were conducted from July 16th to September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2007 among a representative sample of 4,013 Latino respondents age 18 and older. A total of 1,990 were parents of children under 18 years of age and 980 have a chronic illness. The margin of error is +/-1.83% at the 95% confidence level.
